



TRANSPORT SAFETY POLICY

COMMITMENT

Baines Masonry is committed to the safe transportation of our products and compliance with the National Heavy Vehicle Law (HVNL) regulations and the Chain of Responsibility (CoR).

OUR TRANSPORT SAFETY OBJECTIVES ARE TO:

1. Foster commercial arrangements with other responsible organisations that are committed to compliance.
2. Provide workers with easy access to compliance information, instruction, training and supervision.
3. Consult with drivers transporting our products to ascertain to the best of our ability the driver is:
 - 3.1. Fit to drive (e.g. not affected by drugs, alcohol or fatigue).
 - 3.2. Holds the required documentation and qualifications (logbooks, licenses etc.)
 - 3.3. Have completed a pre-start vehicle inspection.
4. Observe vehicles transporting our product to ascertain to the best of our ability:
 - 4.1. The vehicle is roadworthy.
 - 4.2. The weight and dimension limits are not exceeded.
 - 4.3. The load is distributed correctly.
 - 4.4. The load is secured correctly
 - 4.5. That all restraint equipment is appropriate to the load and in serviceable condition.
5. Ensure prime contractors driver schedules do not require drivers to exceed driving hours, regulations or speed limit.
6. Comply with relevant fatigue management work and rest laws.
7. Provide drivers with information on changes in circumstances (such as delays) to allow them to manage/ action any measures that may need to be taken.
8. Report and resolve any vehicle defects immediately.
9. Audit the transport safety system.
10. Conduct corrective and preventative action to facilitate continual improvement to the transport safety systems.
