



## TRANSPORT SAFETY POLICY

## **COMMITMENT**

Baines Masonry is committed to the safe transportation of our products and compliance with the National Heavy Vehicle Law (HVNL) regulations and the Chain of Responsibility (CoR).

## **OUR TRANSPORT SAFETY OBJECTIVES ARE TO:**

- 1. Foster commercial arrangements with other responsible organisations that are committed to compliance.
- 2. Provide workers with easy access to compliance information, instruction, training and supervision.
- 3. Consult with drivers transporting our products to ascertain to the best of our ability the driver is:
  - 3.1. Fit to drive (e.g. not affected by drugs, alcohol or fatigue).
  - 3.2. Holds the required documentation and qualifications (logbooks, licenses etc.)
  - 3.3. Have completed a pre-start vehicle inspection.
- 4. Observe vehicles transporting our product to ascertain to the best of our ability:
  - 4.1. The vehicle is roadworthy.
  - 4.2. The weight and dimension limits are not exceeded.
  - 4.3. The load is distributed correctly.
  - 4.4. The load is secured correctly
  - 4.5. That all restraint equipment is appropriate to the load and in serviceable condition.
- 5. Ensure prime contractors driver schedules do not require drivers to exceed driving hours, regulations or speed limit.
- 6. Comply with relevant fatigue management work and rest laws.
- 7. Provide drivers with information on changes in circumstances (such as delays) to allow them to manage/ action any measures that may need to be taken.
- 8. Report and resolve any vehicle defects immediately.
- 9. Audit the transport safety system.
- 10. Conduct corrective and preventative action to facilitate continual improvement to the transport safety systems.
